TERMS & CONDITIONS

Entries

Entries must be submitted to the show secretary by email or post using the supplied entry form and received by the show secretary <u>no</u> <u>later than Friday 8 November</u>. Acceptance of entries received after this date is at the discretion of the Jersey Classic show committee.

Entry fees

Entry fees must accompany the entry form and are charged on a per cow, per class basis.

Breed

Entries must be J14 or greater

Stock arrival

For those travelling from out of town, stock will be permitted on site from Tuesday 19 November (day prior).

Animal health

TB testing – All cattle entered for this show must be from a TB free herd. Where a herd is from a declared movement control area, cattle (including young stock) must be tested and cleared within 60 days of movement. A copy of the Test Certificate must accompany all entry forms, and checks will be made of TB declaration cards upon arrival of stock. All animals must comply with current Animal Health Board regulations.

NAIT

All exhibitors must comply with NAIT regulations. A NAIT approved RFID tag is mandatory for all movements, and it is the responsibility of exhibitors to record the movement of exhibited stock to and from the Jersey Classic NAIT Number - 545952.

Substitutes

Substitutes will only be accepted for cattle in the same aged class.

Disqualification

Any alteration of conformation of cattle will be considered malpractice and will result in disqualification from the event.

Prizes

All prizes will be in the form of cash, vouchers or product to the value listed in the show schedule.

General rules

<u>Genetic realisation</u>: Points will be awarded for BW ranging from 280-330 (50 points), PW ranging from 360 – 410 (50 points), and Type (50 points). Indexes will be generated by JerseyNZ, from the NZAEL database and based on the 8/11/2024 run. (Note that these indexes are likely to be slightly different from those on Minda or myHerd). Where the class results in a tie, the animals total indexes will be added together to split the animals.

Two females: Must be in milk and all animals must be milked in same herd but family ownership permitted.

Junior group of three: - any combination of calves and/or yearlings.

<u>Novice Exhibitor</u>: Entries must be owned by a Te Awamutu club member, and exhibitor must not have won a 1st prize at an A & P or Club show up to judging of this class. (Does not include On Farm shows).

Senior calf/yearling (born from 1 June - 31 July inclusive)

Junior calf/yearling (born on or after 1 August)

Junior members: 15 and under on 5th November 2024

<u>McGregor challenge</u>: Open to junior members within the TA club area. The entry must be led by the exhibitor and must not be clipped. The class will be judged on the best reared, presented and handled entry.

Unless already stated above, the standard rules of the Agricultural Society will apply. The Jersey Classic committee reserves the right to alter the terms and conditions at any time without notice, including amalgamation of classes with insufficient entries or extend classes with very large entries. Any decision made by the committee will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

8. Genetic realisation (1st - \$75, 2nd - \$35, 3rd - \$25, 4th - \$15)
Points will be awarded for BW ranging from 280-330 (50 points), PW ranging from 360-410
(50 points), and Type (50 points). Indexes will be generated by JerseyNZ, from the NZAEL database and based on the 08/11/2024 run. (Note that these indexes are likely to be slightly different from those on Minda or myHerd reports). - 10. Two females (1st \$75, 2nd \$35, 3rd \$25, 4th \$15) *Must be in milk and both animals must be milked in the same herd but family ownership is permitted.*
- Novice Breeder (1st \$75, 2nd \$35, 3rd \$25, 4th \$15) Entries must be owned by a Te Awamutu club member, and cow must not have won a 1st prize at an A & P or prior Club show. (Does not include On Farm shows).

YOUNG STOCK CLASSES

Young stock entry fees: \$6 per entry per class.

12. Senior yearling (1 June - 31 July) (1st - \$50, 2nd - \$25, 3rd - \$15, 4th - \$10)

13. Junior yearling (1 August -) (1st - \$50, 2nd - \$25, 3rd - \$15, 4th - \$10)

14. Senior calf (1 June - 31 July) (1st - \$50, 2nd - \$25, 3rd - \$15, 4th - \$10)

15. Junior calf (1 August -) (1st - \$50, 2nd - \$25, 3rd - \$15, 4th - \$10)

Junior Female Champion (Champion - \$60, Reserve - \$40)

16. Bull Calf (1 June) (1st - \$50, 2nd - \$25, 3rd - \$15, 4th - \$10)
